THE REVOLT OF THE BOUNTY

The Bounty Revolt is one of the most famous episodes in maritime history. It took place in 1789 aboard HMS Bounty, a ship of the British Royal Navy commanded by Captain William Bligh. The original purpose of the Bounty was to transport breadfruit plants from Tahiti to the West Indies to provide a cheap source of food for plantation slaves. However, the voyage turned into a saga of mutiny, survival and justice.

The Bounty left England in December 1787 and reached Tahiti in October 1788 after a difficult voyage. The crew spent several months there, during which time they became deeply attached to the Tahitian people and way of life. When Captain Bligh ordered the ship back to sea in April 1789, many of the crew were reluctant to leave this tropical paradise.

On 28 April 1789, boatswain Fletcher Christian, supported by some of the crew, mutinied against Captain Bligh. Armed with weapons, the mutineers took control of the ship without bloodshed and abandoned Bligh, along with 18 loyalists, in a longboat in the middle of the sea. Against all the odds, Bligh and his men achieved a remarkable feat of survival, sailing over 6,700 kilometres to reach the island of Timor in Indonesia.

Meanwhile, Fletcher Christian and the mutineers returned to Tahiti, but fearing revenge from the Royal Navy, they left the island with some Tahitian men and women, and settled on the remote island of Pitcairn. There, they burnt the Bounty to erase any trace of their presence. Life on Pitcairn was marked by internal conflict and power struggles, but descendants of the mutineers and Tahitians still live on the island today.

News of the mutiny caused a shock in England and the Royal Navy sent HMS Pandora to capture the mutineers. Fourteen of them were apprehended in Tahiti, but the Pandora was shipwrecked on the way back, and only ten of the captured mutineers were brought back to England to stand trial. Three were hanged, four acquitted and the rest pardoned.

The Bounty Mutiny has inspired many books, films and works of art. It remains a fascinating example of rebellion against authority, survival on the high seas, and the complex consequences of mutiny. The story of the Bounty continues to captivate, symbolising both the defiance of authority and the perils of maritime life in the 18th century.

INTERNET AND WI-FI SERVICES AT SEA

WHY IS COMMUNICATION AT SEA DIFFERENT?

Silversea is providing internet service to all guests on board. As there are no "cell" towers or cable networks at sea, or in many of the remote places we visit, we use cutting-edge satellite technology that is very different to the high-speed broadband you may be accustomed to on land.

At sea, any data is transmitted from the ship to a satellite in space. The satellite sends the data to a ground station where it connects to an internet service provider (ISP) and is then sent to the ship. The distance such data must travel is called "latency" and this is why onboard internet access can be inconsistent or, in some cases, unavailable.

Satellite communications are also affected by weather and the ship's location.

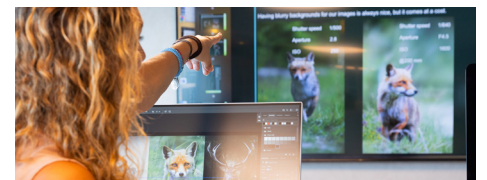
