The City of Churches and Coastal Charm

For those of you that might think that Adelaide lacks behind its coastal counterparts in terms of culture and creativity, think again. Adelaide is a thriving urban city with bright, leafy alleys that beg to be explored. The city's labyrinthine lanes and alleys are bursting with bars and eateries, serving everything from local craft beer to a modern Australian cuisine. Uber aware of their carbon footprint, Adeladians like to keep things close to home, so expect lots of local produce which is abundant, fresh and delicious. Unsurprisingly, Barossa wine from the neighbouring valley features prominently on wine lists everywhere. Naturally, a lot of life centres around the lovely beaches, which are home to surfers, sheltered waters and wide boulevards. The coast is blessed with acres of parkland, perfect for lazing the afternoon away. Many of Australia's most beautiful (and historic) buildings can be found within the boundaries of the city including the handsomely-restored former Railway Building, numerous stately Colonial buildings, St. Peter's Cathedral, the grand old Parliament Buildings and nearby Government House, which all make a worthy addition to any visit. Adelaide is of course known for its wide diversity of faiths, and as such carries its nickname "the city of churches" with pride. Contrary to other Australian penal settlements, Adelaide was a free settlement. This meant that it was also a state free from religious persecution, leading rise to the construction of many churches.

Adelaide Botanic Garden

A lush oasis in the heart of the city, the Adelaide Botanic Garden showcases diverse plant collections, including a stunning Victorian Palm House and the Bicentennial Conservatory. It's perfect for a peaceful stroll or photography.

Glenelg Beach

This iconic beach offers golden sands, calm waters, and a lively promenade. Visitors enjoy swimming, sunset views, and easy access via the historic tram from the city center, making it a favorite coastal escape.

IMPORTANT: AUSTRALIAN BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENTS

Please be aware that strict biosecurity regulations are in place. To protect Australia's unique environment:

1. Do not take any food off the ship;
2. Declare all plant or animal products, including seeds, fruits, meats, dairy, and items made from natural materials;
3. Declare shoes, clothing, or equipment that have been in contact with animals or rural areas (such as hiking boots or farm gear);
4. All bags will be inspected, and failure to declare items can result in significant penalties, including possible visa cancellation.

PORT ADELAIDE PASSENGER TERMINAL INFORMATION

Silver Moon will dock at the Port Adelaide Passenger Terminal, Outer Harbour No. 2 Berth, Oliver Rogers Road. The terminal offers complimentary Wi-Fi, brochures, souvenir shops, and an ATM for your convenience. Please note that currency exchange services are not available at the terminal; the nearest option is in Adelaide city center.

Transportation is easy—metered taxis are available outside the terminal, and Uber operates throughout Adelaide. For those who prefer public transport, the train station is located just across the street, with an approximate 35-minute journey to the city center.

COMPLIMENTARY SHUTTLE SERVICE

A complimentary Shuttle Bus Service will operate between the Pier Cruise Terminal and Mayfair Hotel, Adelaide. We recommend arriving at least 5 minutes prior to the shuttle bus departure at the pickup locations. Allow up to 10 minutes depending on your walking speed to reach the shuttle bus.

Drive distance to downtown: approximately 35-45 minutes on each direction.

First bus departs the pier at 8:30 a.m. last bus departs downtown at 10:15 p.m.

Important Information: Shuttle intervals are approximate and may be affected by local traffic conditions. Silversea and its agents cannot accept liability for any unforeseen delays. A short break in service will occur during driver meal times. The shuttle service is intended to supplement local transportation; guests requiring greater flexibility may wish to arrange a taxi at their own expense rather than wait for the shuttle.
