Seoul: a 2000 years history

Seoul is the capital city of South Korea, with a long and rich history dating back more than 2,000 years. The city was founded in 18 BC by the Baekje Kingdom, one of the three kingdoms that ruled the Korean Peninsula at the time. It was originally called Wiryeseong, and served as the capital of the Baekje Kingdom for over 500 years.

In 1394, the Joseon Dynasty was established, and Seoul became its capital. During this time, the city was known as Hanyang, and it grew in importance as a center of politics, culture, and trade. The Joseon Dynasty lasted until 1910, when Korea was annexed by Japan.

Following World War II, Korea was liberated from Japanese colonial rule, and Seoul became the capital of the newly formed Republic of Korea in 1948. The city underwent rapid growth and development in the post-war period, with the construction of new buildings, roads, and infrastructure.

In the 1960s and 70s, Seoul experienced a period of rapid industrialization and modernization, which led to significant social and economic changes. The city's population grew rapidly, and it became one of the largest cities in the world.

In the 1980s and 90s, Seoul underwent a period of democratization, with the establishment of a more democratic government and the rise of a strong civil society movement. This period saw significant improvements in human rights, freedom of speech, and political participation.

Today, Seoul is a thriving metropolis and a global hub of technology, innovation, and culture. It continues to evolve and adapt to the changing needs of its citizens and visitors, while also preserving its rich history and cultural heritage.

DEOKSUGUNG PALACE

Deoksugung Palace, a walled compound of palaces in Seoul that was inhabited by members of Korea's Royal Family during the Joseon monarchy until the annexation of Korea by Japan in 1910. Initially it was not a royal palace, but a residential home of Grand Prince Wolsan, the older brother of King Seongjong of the Joseon dynasty. It wasn't until 1593 that the palace was used as a temporary palace of the royal family after their home was burned down during the Imjin War. The name did not change officially to Deoksugung Palace, meaning the "palace of virtuous longevity," until 1907.
