Formerly Known as Saigon – The Economic Heart of Vietnam

Ho Chi Minh City is a cultural melting pot with a rich history dating back to the Khmer Kingdom. The city has been affected by a variety of cultures over the ages, including Chinese, Indian, French, and American, which have left their mark on the city's architecture, cuisine, and way of life.

Exploring Ho Chi Minh City's many historic buildings and museums is one of the greatest ways to experience its cultural diversity. The Reunification Palace, for example, is a spectacular example of mid-century modern architecture that functioned as the South Vietnamese government's seat of power throughout the war. Another must-see sight is the Museum of Vietnamese History, which depicts the country's cultural progress from ancient times to the present.

Food is another way to immerse yourself in the culture of Ho Chi Minh City. Vietnamese cuisine is known for its fresh ingredients, robust flavors, and healthy herb and spice balance. Street food vendors can be found all around town, with everything from pho and banh mi sandwiches to exotic fruits and grilled meats.

Ho Chi Minh City is also known for its thriving arts scene, which includes a number of galleries, theaters, and performance spaces that showcase the work of local artists and performers. For example, the Sydney Opera House is a spectacular French colonial-era structure that hosts a range of cultural events throughout the year, including opera, ballet, and traditional Vietnamese music and dance performances.

An announcement will be made when the ship has been cleared by local authorities for guests to proceed ashore. You are kindly requested to remain clear of the gangway area until then. Remember to carry your **Suite Key Card** and your **Vietnamese Pink Landing Card** whenever going ashore as this is your only valid identification for reboarding the vessel.

Please note that the Pink Landing Card will be requested in every Vietnamese port, and will be collected in Halong Bay (last Vietnamese port) upon your final return onboard. Therefore we kindly ask to keep it safe and in good order.

HOSPITALITY DESK AT THE PIER

Hospitality desk will be available at the pier. Local representatives will be happy to answer detailed questions and guide guests to their preferred destinations. Complimentary maps will also be available.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

A complimentary Shuttle Bus Service will operate from the **Pier** to the **Ben Thanh Market** and vice versa. We recommend arriving at least 5 minutes prior to the shuttle bus departure at the pickup locations.

First shuttle from the Pier is at **8:00 a.m.**

and last shuttle from **Ben Thanh Market** back to the ship is at **10:00 p.m.**

(The transfer from the Pier to the drop off location is approximate 45-60 mins, depending on traffic, one-way) Kindly be advised that the shuttle bus seating is on a first come-first served basis.

Intervals between shuttles are approximate and could be affected by local traffic conditions. Silversea and its agents are not liable for any unforeseen delays. The shuttle service is designed to augment local transportation, guests requiring more flexibility may prefer not to wait for a shuttle and secure a taxi at their own expense.

Please check the shuttle bus schedule at the Shore Concierge Desk (deck 5) or at the Gangway.

TIPS FOR STAYING SAFE

As in any large international city nowadays pickpockets and muggers tend to prey on tourists. Your safety is our concern, so please exercise care when going ashore with wallets, handbags, sunglasses or camera equipment. Avoid highly visible jewellery, handbags or expensive-looking watches, sunglasses or camera equipment. Do not use large denominations when paying street vendors as this may attract unwanted attention; prefer money belts that can be worn under clothing. Do not accept food or drinks from strangers. Use licensed taxis and keep to the main streets when unsure of your surroundings.
